You may experience loss of DNS service after you have downloaded and installed iTunes 5 from Apple Web site.

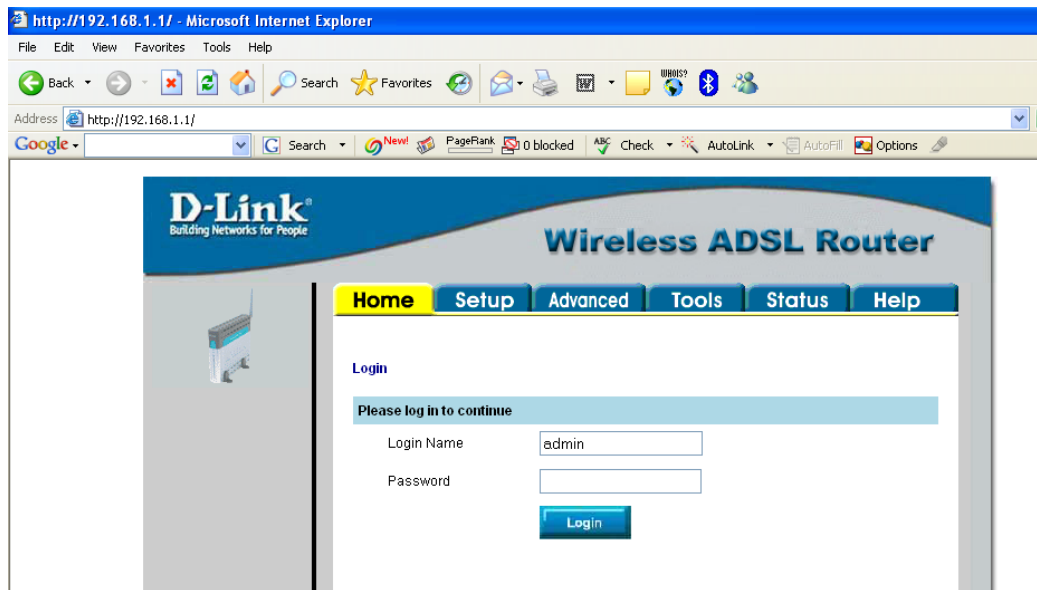
Please reset your DNS settings as detailed below to restore DNS functionality.

DNS Setting on PC - Procedure (Windows XP/2000)

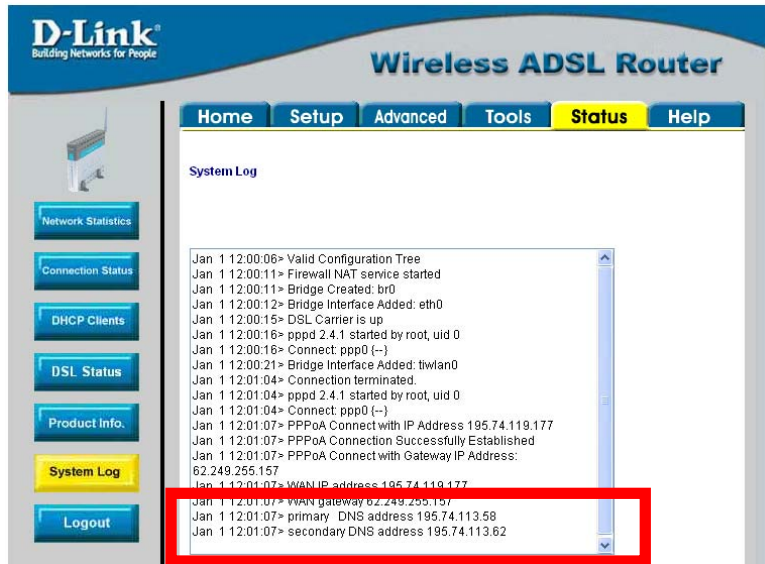
You will need the DNS IP address of your ISP. You can find this IP Address in system log of the DSL-G604T. Follow the procedure below to determine this.

Login to the DSL-G604T router.



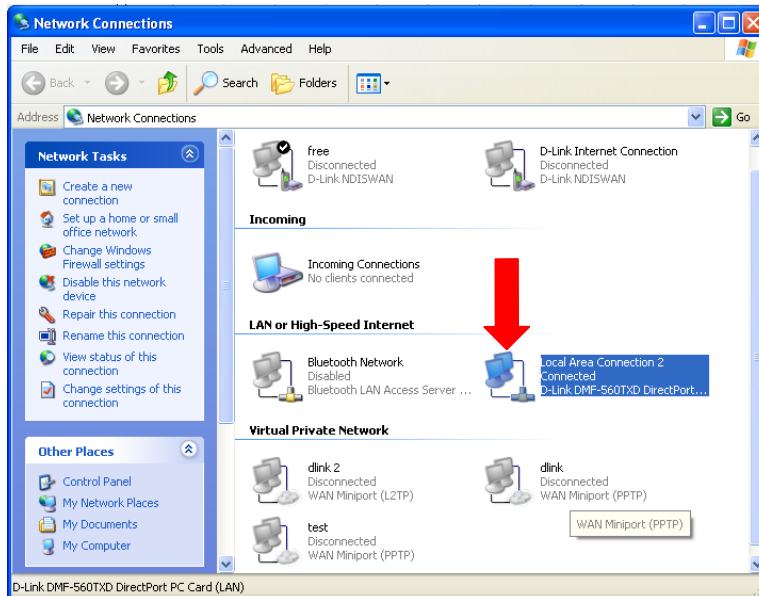
Go to Status → System Log

Make a note of the primary DNS and Secondary DNS addresses

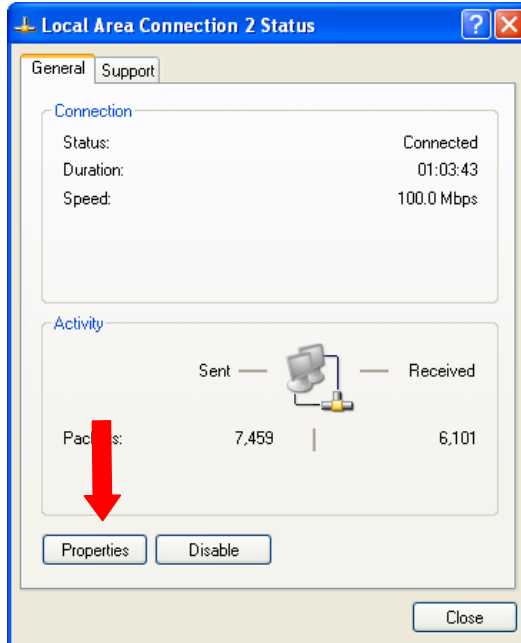


Now, on your PC, follow the steps below.

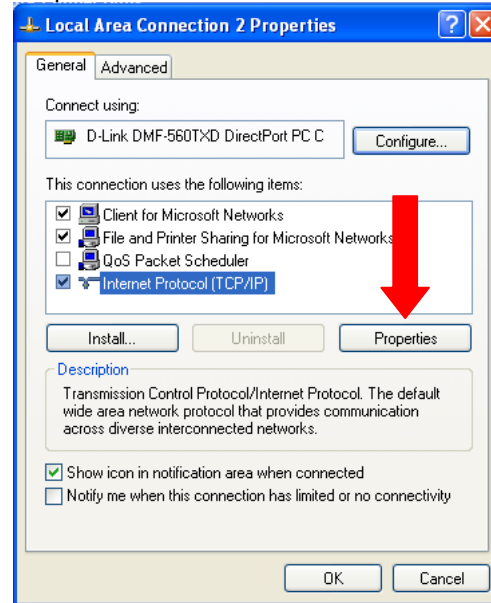
Start → Control Panel → Network Connections and double click on your network adapter



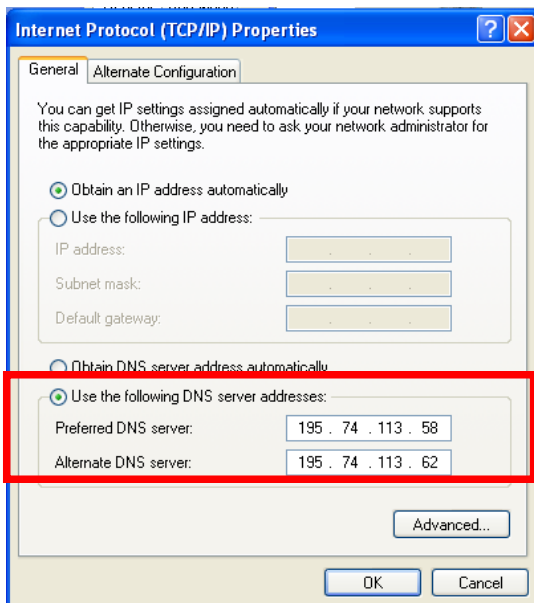
Select Properties



Select Internet Protocol (TCP/IP) and Properties

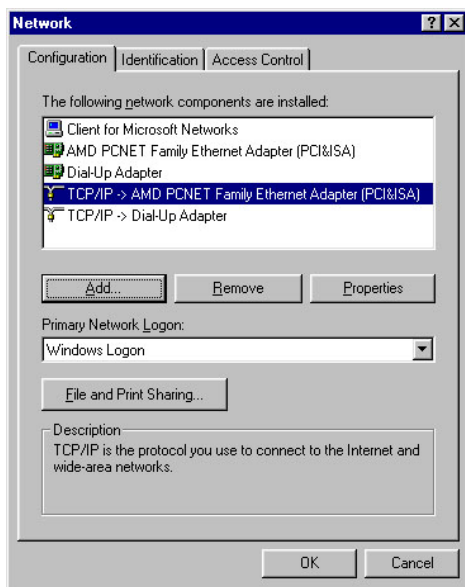
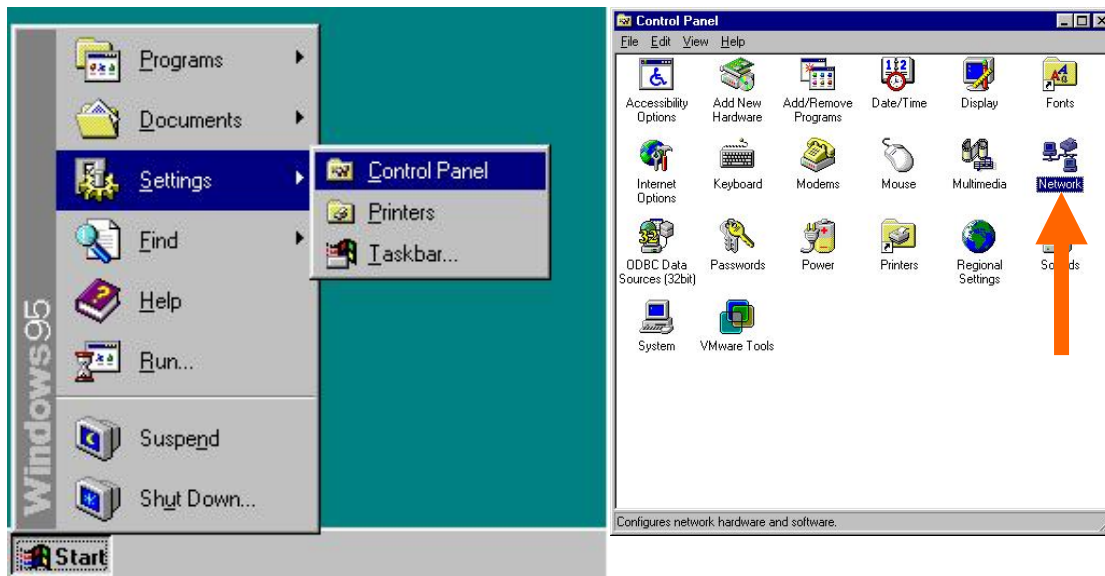


Preferred DNS server = Primary DNS address
Alternate DNS server = Secondary DNS address



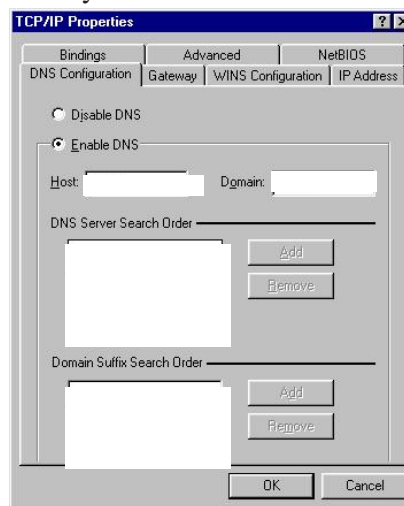
Enter the ISP DNS Server information and Click OK

Select the TCP/IP option and click on Properties

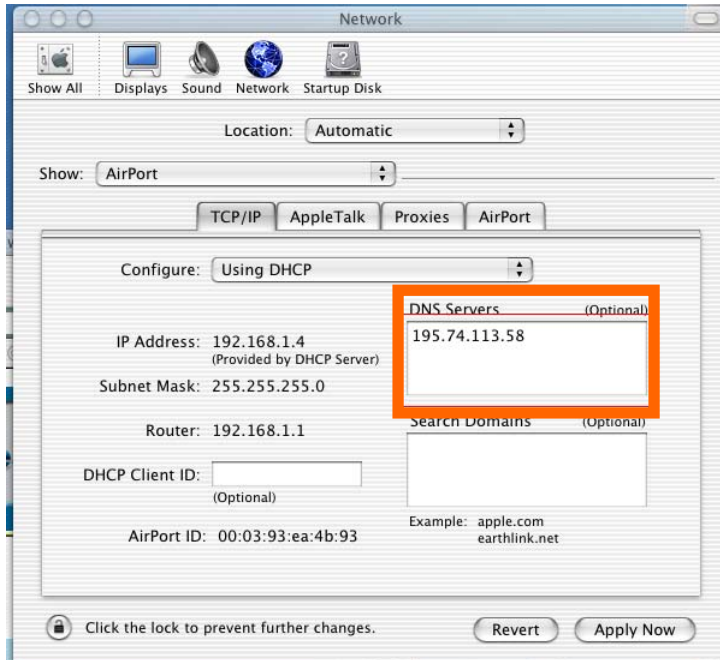
Enter your ISP DNS details
