How to change the SSID network name?

Method 1

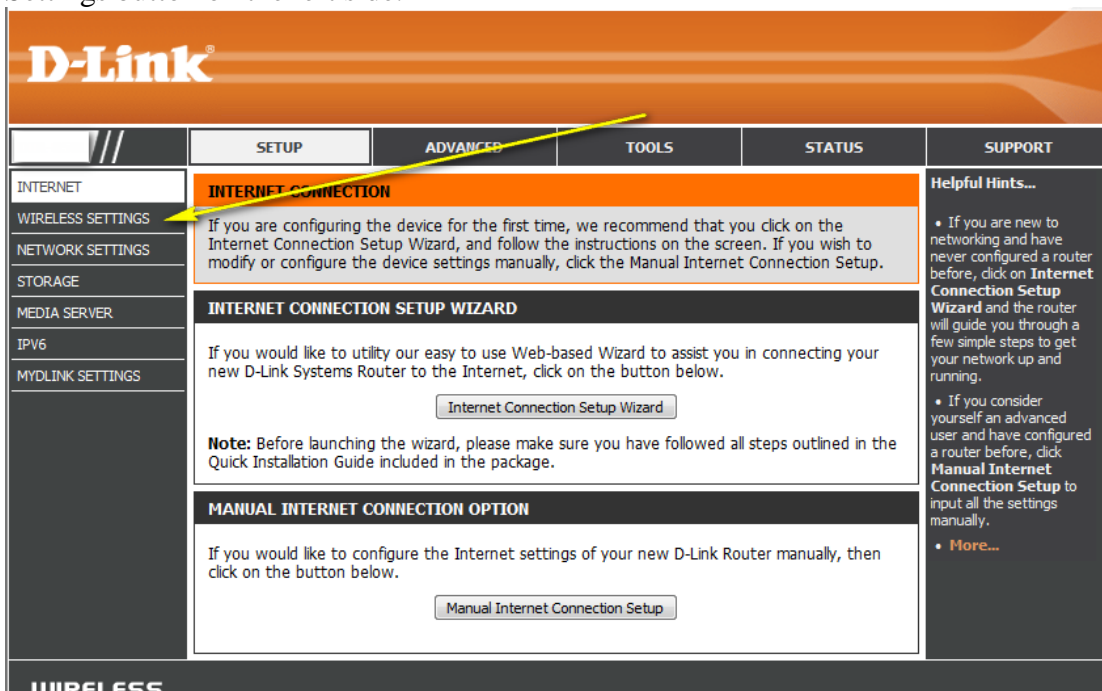
Step 1: Open your web browser and enter <http://dlinkrouter> or <http://dlinkrouter.local> or <http://192.168.0.1> into the address bar.



The default username is Admin and the password is blank (nothing). Click Login.



Step 2: Click on the Setup tab on the top of the configuration page and then click the Wireless Settings button on the left side.



Step 3: Click on Manual Wireless Connection Setup

Helpful Hints...

- Changing your Wireless Network Name is the first step in securing your wireless network. We recommend that you change it to a familiar name that does not contain any personal information.
- Enable Auto Channel Selection let the router can select the best possible channel for your wireless network to operate on.
- Enabling Hidden Mode is another way to secure your network. With this option enabled, no wireless clients will be able to see your wireless network when they perform a scan to see what's available. In order for your wireless devices to connect to your router, you will need to

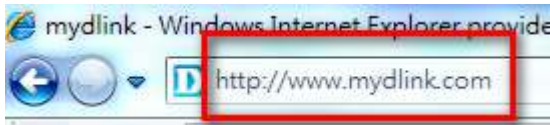
Step 5: Click Save Settings to save your settings.

Step 1: Go to <https://www.mydlink.com>

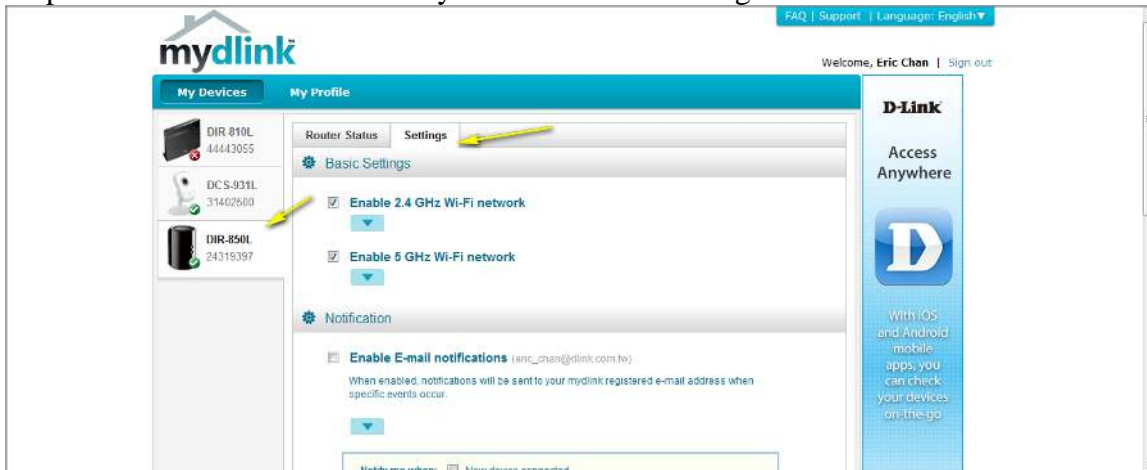

Step 6: Select Yes if you would like to apply the new settings to the router. It will take at least 80 seconds to save the changes and reboot the router.
